To register a team, please go to www.nwdasa.org to get the appropriate paperwork. We have changed our fee structure this year. All players will owe a \$60 registration fee. This includes their ASA registration. Coaches will also owe a \$10 ASA registration. **There will be NO TEAM FEE.** Registration paperwork with all money is due on April 15. All paperwork, including birth certificates, must be completed to register a team.

All coaches, assistant coaches, and/or parents on the playing field or in the dug-outs MUST HAVE an ASA coach's card. This means that they must pay for and pass the background check and ACE Certification test at www.registerasa.com. These must be completed by the April 30. If these two things have not happened, the individuals who have not done them will not be allowed in the dug-out or on the field. If none of the coaches or parents have completed them, the team will not be allowed to participate.
